

(6) OBJECTIVES FROM JOINT POSITION STATEMENT by

Allied Organisations Engaged in Revolutionary Struggle towards Annihilation of Military Dictatorship and Establishment of a Federal Democratic Union

- A. To overturn the usurpation of state power by the military, and to terminate the involvement of the armed forces in politics.
- B. To ensure that all armed forces operate solely under the command of a civilian government elected through democratic processes.
- C. To abrogate the constitution of 2008 in its entirety, and to quash all attempts to reinstate its provisions.
- D. To draft and promulgate a new constitution that embodies federalism and democratic values, garnering the consensus of all relevant parties.
- E. To establish a new federal democratic union in accordance with the proposed federal democratic constitution.
- F. To institute a system of transitional justice in order to address and remedy the injustices inflicted upon innocent parties throughout the conflict.

schools, and healthcare buildings have been destroyed because of the junta's violence.

ILO Conference Decides to continue action against Myanmar Junta's Labor Rights Violations

The NUG released a statement sharing that the 114th International Labor Conference (ILC) discussed labor and human rights conditions in Myanmar and decided to continue taking action against the terrorist military junta's violations. A special meeting on Myanmar was held during the conference, focusing

primarily on the junta's violations of ILO conventions. The conference expressed deep concern over the ongoing arrests, torture, and threats against labor unions and activists, as well as the continued use of forced labor during the post-coup period. The committee has demanded that the military authorities submit

an implementation report on the recommendations of the ILO Commission of Inquiry before September 21, 2026, and these submissions will be further discussed in November.

Investigation continues for Two Mandalay PDF Officials, NUG Ministry of Defense announces

Ko Mone Dai and Ko Naing Gyi from the People's Defense Force (Mandalay) are under ongoing investigation by the NUG Ministry of Defense for disciplinary violations, including the withdrawal and use of the unit's funds and gold, and according to the investigation, Ko Mone Dai and Ko Naing Gyi were found to have withdrawn 16.6 viss of gold belonging to the unit against official procedures. Although both have confessed to the matter, they have not yet returned it. Therefore, since November 2025, they have been suspended from all duties, disarmed, and placed in detention, and the Ministry of

Defense informed that they are currently being well-detained in accordance with military laws and regulations, and the investigation is continuing.
